BALOO - Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation for Cub Scout leaders is a one-day training event that introduces participants to the skills needed to plan and conduct Pack outdoor activities, particularly pack camping. This training is required for any adult who is in charge of planning a pack campout, and it is required that at least one adult per pack complete BALOO training in order to submit a tour plan. BALOO training is offered twice a year by the PA Dutch Council's Training Team.

Those taking the course should bring their Cub Scout Leader Book, notebook, and a pen/pencil.

Course opening ceremony is at 8:30 am. Course runs to 4:00 pm. Lunch is provided.
