*The IOLS Exemption Qualification event is **ONLY** for leaders who are confident in their ability to **perform and teach ALL** outdoor skills necessary for a youth to achieve the rank of "First Class".*

The IOLS Exemption Qualification event will be held on February 18th, 2012 at Camp Mack. Participants who are successful in completing this day-long, hands-on examination of the Outdoor Skills taught in the BSA's Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills Course will be given a training exemption from completing the overnight IOLS Course. By registering for this event, you must be 100% confident in your knowledge of the Outdoor Skills found in the Boy Scouting program. Specifically, those skills required for a boy to earn the ranks of Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class. If you are not 100% confident in your ability to demonstrate these skills, the Council Training Committee recommends that you register for the IOLS Training Course. If you choose to register for the Exemption Qualification Event and fail your examination, you will be required to take the full IOLS Training Course; so please be sure you are 100% confident in your Outdoor Skills knowledge before signing up.

Following your registration, you will be contacted with detailed information regarding your preparation for the Exemption Qualification and personal gear you will be required to bring for the day.
