Webelos leaders needing Outdoor skills for Webelos Leaders (OWLs) will receive credit for both OWLS and IOLS by attending this course.

November 2-4, 2012 – at Camp Mack

*The training is designed to teach you the skills needed to help the boys
move from Tenderfoot through First Class ranks.*

Course Introduction:

This course will run very much in a troop setting where you will be formed into patrols with a Patrol Leader, with the patrols being run by a Senior Patrol Leader. A Scoutmaster, and several Troop Guides will be present to aid in the training weekend. Field (Class "A") uniform is recommended.

Check in for the course will be 6:30pm Friday evening with the course beginning at 8:00pm on Friday until approximately lunchtime on Sunday. The patrols will be responsible for three meals over the course of the weekend: Saturday breakfast, Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast. All other meals (Saturday lunch, crackerbarrels) will be provided by the staff. Those meals that the patrols provide must be purchased and brought to the course along with the receipts so that the purchaser can be reimbursed from council by check.

Those taking the course will be responsible for their own personal gear; tent, sleeping bag, pillow, personal hygiene items, mess kit, etc. The patrol will be responsible to provide the cooking equipment for their meals, as no equipment is available for loan at the course.

Those taking the course should bring their Scout Handbook, notebook, pencil/pen, and a compass. Since the course will be run in a similar fashion to a troop, patrols should have conversation about a patrol name, cheer and flag before arriving Friday night.

Webelos Leaders need an additional session during the weekend. Note your intent on registration form.

Most importantly, keep in mind that this course WILL BE FUN!
