#### **INTERNET ADVANCEMENT**

Units should be recording advancement through <a href="https://www.myscouting.org">www.myscouting.org</a>. If you have not started this process please contact Karen Glover at the Council office for your unit's pin number.

**Follow these simple steps:** 

- 1. Log on to your my scouting account
- 2. Click on the internet advancement button on the left side, it is about half way down the list.
- 3. Then click on first time user, this is where you will need the unit id. If the unit id has already been used you will need to contact Karen to have it reset.
- 4. You will create a password. Note there can only be one password per unit id.
- 5. Download the roster from scoutnet. This is the best option. Depending on your internet speed and size of unit this may take a few minutes.
- 6. Enter the advancements for each scout & save.
- 7. You may view a draft of the advancement report before you submit the report.
- 8. Submit the report.
- 9. You will have the opportunity to submit comments. Click on submit.
- 10. Lastly print the advancement report. Sign the report and bring 2 copies to the Scout Shop to purchase your advancement.

Rank advancement awards can **NOT be purchased** without a report.

Packs need to record rank advancement & webelos activity badge information. All other awards & belt loops are not required to be recorded at this time.

Troops need to record all rank advancements and merit badges
