All adult application must have uploaded the Pennsylvania State required clearance forms and been approved prior to submission to the Council Service Center. In addition Youth Protection training must be completed and current. The training is valid for 2 years. Merit Badge Counselor applicants need to have completed Merit Badge Counselor Training in addition to YPT.
