## **BASHORE SCOUT RESERVATION - BOY SCOUT CAMP**

There is still space available at Bashore for a fun summer adventure. Weeks 2 and 4 are full and weeks 1, 3, and 5 are close to being closed. Reserve your patrol sites today to guarantee your week. Individual non-refundable deposits are due no later than March 15 at the Scout Office to secure spots at camp. A \$25 deposit is needed per scout attending summer camp. Final payments are due no later than May 15 at the Scout Office. After May 15 an additional \$15 per scout is added to the total payment. Remittal forms will be mailed to unit leaders in February.

## MACK SCOUT RESERVATION - CUB SCOUT CAMP

Non-refundable deposits are due no later than March 15 for each scout to reserve space at camp. Weekend Sessions fill quickly so don't wait to register! A \$25 deposit is required per scout. It is preferred that everyone register as a unit with one unit check. Final payments for scouts and adults are due no later than May 10 at the Scout Office. After May 10 an additional \$20 per scout will be added to the total.

# **ADVANCEMENT PURCHASES**

**Internet Advancement is mandatory!** Contact Karen Glover at the Council office for your unit's ID number.

Once you have submitted your report please print a unit advancement report. Two signed copies of your unit's advancement report are required when purchasing rank advancement emblems. One copy is for the Council and the other for your District Advancement Chair. Rank advancement awards can NOT be purchased without a report.

## **TOUR PLAN REMINDERS**

A few reminders about tour plan submission:

- 1. Tour Plans are needed whenever you leave the Council borders, camp overnight regardless of borders, or plan an activity requiring special training such as boating & swimming.
- 2. You may file electronically through your my scouting account. See additional article on this process.
- 3. The tour plan leader and the committee chair or charter rep must sign the plan when using the hard copy form.
- 4. One registered leader must have YPT and Hazardous Weather training. These trainings expire every 2 years.
- 5. Tour Plans can be faxed to (717)394-7776, mailed to the council office, or brought in.
- 6. Vehicle information is needed for anyone transporting people other than their own family members.

Tour Plans may be filed through your My Scouting account. You will login at your my scouting account and complete the tour plan on line. Your login will serve as your signature.

If you are missing information the program will alert you with red & yellow flags. Red flags are a must to be corrected. Often times yellow flags relate to missing emails or parent drivers who may not have youth protection training. Please go to our Council website and watch the tour plan demo.
