Wilderness First Aid (WFA) is the assessment of and treatment given to an ill or injured person in a remote environment where definitive care by a physician and/or rapid transport is not readily available. Youth and adult Scout leaders over age 14 are invited to participate and earn their certification. Course is limited to 24 participants

(You must have a current CPR Certification to receive WFA Certification)
