Other Information: This is a family event in a Pack family camping setting. Packs and families need to provide all of their own camping equipment - including tents, cooking equipment (propane fuel only), lanterns and meals (excluding Saturday lunch).

*> Boy Scouts will be available if you need assistance in setting up your tent.*

- \* Sturdy, camp appropriate shoes - for safety reasons, no open toe shoes, no flip flops.
- \* We will have a boating session - proper swimwear and shower shoes optional.
- \* Shower and restroom facilities will be available all weekend.
- \* **Pets are not allowed in camp.**
- \* Campsite assignment will be on check in packet - each family will get a check in packet.
- \* Trading Post will be open - hours will be posted.

Medical Forms: **ALL campers MUST have a completed health form - Parts A & B** (includes adults and siblings. *Health forms must be given to the Health Officer at check in. Please see the Health Officer after closing ceremony on Sunday to pick up health forms - any health forms not picked up will be shredded.*

## Suggested Cub-0-Ree Weekend Packing List

This list is provided as a simple guideline to plan what you will need for your weekend at the the Cub-0-Ree. We suggest you pack your clothing items in plastic bags to keep them dry.

Clothing and personal property should be permanently marked with your name and Pack/Troop number. There is a lost and found located in the Health Lodge.

Medications should be clearly marked with patient's name, medication name and dosage.

Medications should be kept at the campsite in a safe place in the possession of a responsible adult

### Official BSA Uniform:

- Short Sleeved Shirt (Blue or Khaki)
- Neckerchief and slide

### Clothing:

- Socks (4 or 5 pair)
- Tee Shirts (4)
- Underwear (4)
- Pair of long pants
- Pair of shorts (4 pair)
- Sweatshirt/Jacket
- Sleepwear
- Comfortable walking shoes (2 pair)  
*(No open-Toe Sandals or Shoes)*
- Raingear/Poncho (No Umbrellas)
- Bathing suit and Beach Towel  
*(Water shoes/ flipflops are allowed in pool area/showers only.)*
- Baseball style cap

### Toiletries:

- Soap in a plastic bag
- Towels and washcloth (1-2)
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Comb or brush
- Deodorant
- Shampoo

### PLEASE LEAVE THE FOLLOWING AT HOME:

Electronic devices like cell phones, Game Systems, Radios, etc.

Knives, axes, saws, fireworks, etc.

**All aerosol products**

### Camping Gear:

- Tent and setup equipment
- Cooking gear/plates, cups, utensils
- Food in plastic tote
- Supplies to wash cooking tools
- Duffie bag for clothing, toiletries, etc.
- Backpack for water bottle, sunscreen, etc.
- Flashlight (with extra batteries)
- Water Bottle
- Dirty laundry bag

### Bedding:

- Sleeping pad
- Sleeping bag or blankets
- Pillow and pillow case
- Sheet

### Other Items:

- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen and sunglasses
- Medications (clearly labeled)
- Folding chair
- Board/Card games
- Cub Scout handbook
- Notebook and pencils
- Spending money (for Trading Post)
- Camera
- Tissues
