- Enclosed sides are also not be allowed. This is violating the Mall Fire Hazard code.
- We will provide each booth with two (2) chairs. If you need additional chairs, please bring your own.
- **Lebanon Valley Mall does not permit cooking in the mall.**
- Any unit who dismantles their booth prior to the closing ceremony on Friday, Feb. 8th will be disqualified from any booth judging!
- ANY UNIT THAT DOES NOT FOLLOW THE ABOVE GUIDELINES WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR ANY JUDGING AND MAY BE ASKED TO TAKE DOWN THEIR BOOTH DISPLAY.
