Handicraft

- Art Explosion (Requirements finished)
 - <u>1-</u> Visit an art gallery (set up at family night dinner)
 - <u>2-</u> Create two self-portraits using the two different techniques of drawing and painting
 - <u>3A-</u> Draw or paint an original picture outdoors.
 - \circ <u>3B/3C-</u> Use clay to create a simple pinch pot
 - \circ <u>4B-</u> Display your artwork in a pack, school, or community art show.

Campcraft

- Castaway
 - \circ <u>1A</u>-With the help of an adult, demonstrate one way to light a fire without matches
 - <u>1C-</u> Using tree limbs or branches that have already fallen or been cut, build a shelter that could protect you overnight.
 - <u>2F-</u> Demonstrate 2 ways to treat drinking water to remove impurities.
 - <u>2G-</u> Discuss what to do if you become lost in the woods. Ex-S-T-O-P
 - <u>2H-</u> Make a list of 4 qualities you think a leader should have in an emergency. How does it relate to the scout law?
- **Camper** (Most requirements completed at outpost)
 - \circ <u>1-</u> With the help of your den, conduct a campout.
 - <u>2-</u> Determine where to set up your tent. Demonstrate knowledge of what makes a good/bad campsite.
 - <u>3A,B,C-</u> Once your tents are set up determine what actions you should take in case of certain emergencies.
 - <u>5-</u> Show/teach how to tie a bowline. Explain when this knot should be used and why. Teach it to another scout.
 - <u>7-</u> Recite the Outdoor Code and Leave No Trace Principles from memory.

Nature

- Into the Wild
 - <u>4-</u> Learn about bird flyways closest to your home. Find out which birds use these flyways.
 - \circ <u>5-</u> Watch at least four wild creatures in the wild. Tell what they were doing.
 - <u>6-</u> Identify an insect, reptile, bird or other wild animal that is only found in your area of the country. Tell why it only survives in your area.
 - \circ <u>7-</u> Give at least two examples of how humans have changed the balance of nature.
 - \circ <u>8-</u> Learn about aquatic ecosystems and wetlands in your area.
 - \circ <u>9A-</u> Explore the nature lodge.
- Into the Woods (Requirements finished)
 - \circ <u>1-</u> Identify 2 different groups of trees and the parts of a tree.
 - <u>2-</u> Identify 6 common trees to your area where you live. Tell how both wildlife and humans use them.
 - <u>3-</u> Identify 6 plants common to the area where you live. Tell what animals use them and for what purpose.
 - <u>4-</u> Visit the nature lodge. Explain how plants and trees are important to our ecosystem.
 - \circ <u>5-</u> Develop a plan to care for and then plant at least one plant or tree.
 - \circ <u>6-</u> Make a list of items that are made from wood and share it with your den.
 - <u>7-</u> Explain how the growth rings of a tree trunk tell its life story. Describe different types of tree bark and explain what bark does for the tree.
