Training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters of Scouts BSA troops is divided into two courses. This course (classroom or online) concerns troop planning and operations and working with the youth. The Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills (IOLS) course teaches the outdoor skills required for the Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class ranks. It also provides a patrol experience.

The goal of this training is fourfold. All participants who complete the sessions should:

- 1. Confidently recognize that being a Scoutmaster is a manageable challenge.
- 2. Understand where to find abundant available resources.
- 3. Know that the structure of the Boy Scouts of America ensures that they are part of a supportive team working to deliver the promise of Scouting to the youth of America.
- 4. Have a short action plan to apply what they have learned.

Those taking the course should bring their Scouts BSA Handbook, Scoutmaster's Handbook (if you have one), a notebook, and a pen/pencil. **Participants should also bring a lunch.**

Participants should bring a COPY of parts A & B of their BSA Medical Form with them. Field uniform ("Class A") is appropriate attire.

You will have fun, learn about resources, gain confidence, and become a better leader.

This course is a 1-Day classroom session ONLY. If you plan to take the Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills (IOLS) course you MUST register separately for that training.
