Important Notes

- BSA Medical Forms A and B are required of all youth and adult participants for overnight events. All units are requested to submit their medical forms to the Council Office or during October's Round Table in order to expedite event check-in.
- National policy prohibits Lions from participating with BB gun shooting.
- Per PA Dutch Council policy, shooting sports participants must be age 6 or older.
- Lions and Tigers must have one-on-one supervision at all times.
- A responsible adult is required for every Cub Scout/Webelos Scout who is camping overnight.
