Trainer's EDGE is the required "Train the Trainer" course for Wood Badge and NYLT staffs. The purpose of Trainer's EDGE is to provide and help develop the platform skills of a trainer. It is meant to supplement the practice offered through Wood Badge and NYLT staff development, with a focus on the participant, while raising the level of skill a trainer brings to the staff experience. Only practice can polish these skills, but this course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media.

Pre-Course Preparation: Participants should prepare a **10 to 12 minute presentation** on a topic from any BSA material; that may be part of a Wood Badge or NYLT presentation. You will deliver this presentation during the course; bring ALL needed materials and equipment. Your presentation should allow you to demonstrate the skills of a trainer. You will receive constructive feedback on your presentation from other participants. This is an essential part of the course. **Be Prepared.**

You will have fun, learn about resources, gain confidence, and become a better trainer.
