D. Spring Allium Mix

Hard working and easy to grow! These pleasingly fragrant blooms make great varieties for bees and butterflies, while at the same time are rodent and deer resistant. Plant 2-3" apart and 2-3" deep in well-drained soil in full sun to partial shade.

The best available virus-free strawberry plants. Large, red, julcy berries in the spring and throughout the summer. These are top performers and will yield firm berries with excellent flavor. Spring Planting, Bloom: Spring and Summer, Ht: 10"

Stately blooms in a dazzling multicolored assortment. Plant 6-9" apart and 3" deep in well-drained soil and In full sun or shaded areas for best results. If soil is dry, add water and


J. New Tiger Lilies




