

When you decide to attend Philmont, you must be physically fit, have proper clothing and equipment, be willing to follow instructions, work as a team with your crew and take responsibility for your own health and safety. Philmont is not risk free and you should be prepared to listen to safety instructions carefully, follow directions and take appropriate steps to safeguard yourself and others. Scouts must be at least First Class before attending and age 14 by January 1, 2024. Adult spaces are limited. The High Adventure Committee reserves the right to select adult participants based upon Philmont's adult to youth participation ratio, Scouting Background, and BSA Policy. All participants must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America. The approximate *all-inclusive* cost including shakedown training, airfare, charter bus, meals and pre-Philmont touring is \$3175.00 per person.
