G. Spectacular Gladiolus Stately blooms in a dazzling multicolored assortment. Plant 6-9" apart and 3" deep in well-drained soil and in full sun or shaded areas for best results. If soil is dry, add water and fertilize.

H. Crocosmia Mix Our orange, red and yellow trumpetshaped flowers will attract pollinators such as hummingbirds and butterflies. They thrive in full sun and open in succession from the bottom up like gladiolus. They have sword-shaped foliage which adds an attractive vertical element to any garden. Plant 3" deep and 4" apart with pointed ends facing UP. Spring Planting, Bloom: June-August Ht: 3-4'

I. Stargazer Lilles

Pink to crimson, with white edges and dark spots on these beautiful blooms. Plant in full sun to partial shade. This plant prefers well-drained soil but will tolerate heavier soils. Plant 6" deep and 9-12" apart. Spring Planting, Bloom: July-

September, Ht: 25-30"

M. Ranunculus Mix

Lovely mix of colors will bloom from these mixed corms. They are perfect for borders, beds, containers and cut flowers. Plant 4-6" apart and 2" deep in full to partial sun. Water well in drained-soil and maintain average moisture.

J. Pink Rain Lilies

These bulbs will produce an abundance of charming, large pink flowers for an incredibly long period of time, June through September. Perfect to use as groundcover or with a rock garden. Plant 4" deep and 6" apart. Spring Planting, Bloom: Mid to Late Summer (3-5 days after a rain shower). Ht: 6-12"



K. Variegated Hosta

The variegated varieties need more sunlight to keep their white and golden stripes. All hostas need shade and few will do well in strong, direct sunlight. Plant in a hole about twice the width and depth of the root ball of the plant. Spring Planting, Bloom: Late Summer, Ht: 18-32"



L. Elf Lilies

Naturally low-growing. Great for pots, planters or borders. You will love these easy-to-grow flowers! Plant 4" deep and 6" apart in full to partial sun and in Spring Planting, Bloom: July-



P. Peacock Orchid This annual holds onto summer with a sweet-scented late bloomer.

Elegant, creamy-white 4" flowers with a prominent purple center atop sturdy stem. Plant 3-5" deep and 3-6" apart in full sun and keep well-drained soil moist. Easy to grow!



O. Baboon Flower Mix Baboon Flowers produce clusters of

showy, trumpet-shaped flowers in striking shades of purple, pink, and white. Compact and low-growing. perfect for rock gardens, borders, or container planting. Plant 2-3" deep and 2-4" apart in well-drained soil. Full sun is preferred but light shade is recommended for hotter climates. Spring planting, Bloom 10-12 weeks after planting, Ht: 8-12"




R. Bleeding Hearts

A romantic favorite from Victorian gardens with arching branches with rows of delicate pink heart-shaped flowers. Extremely vigorous. Plant in partial shade and in moist, welldrained soil.



- 3. Use provided order form to submit order to the Council (forms will be also be available on the Council's website to assist with this step)
- 4. Submit 75% of your unit's total sales with payment unit keeps commission of 25%
- 5. Dutch Mill Bulbs will ship all brochure orders to the Council for free
- 6. Pick-up your flower bulb order from Council offices
- 7. Sort and distribute to the members of your Unit
- 8. Remind Scouts to thank their supporters when delivering their flower bulbs
