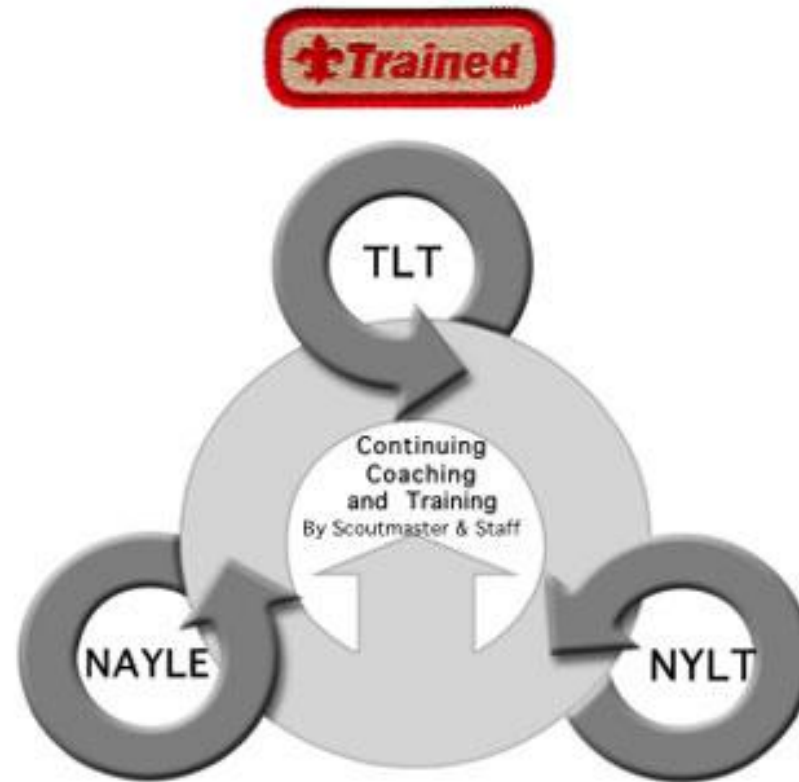

  - Experienced leaders will guide you through the course providing valuable feedback and support



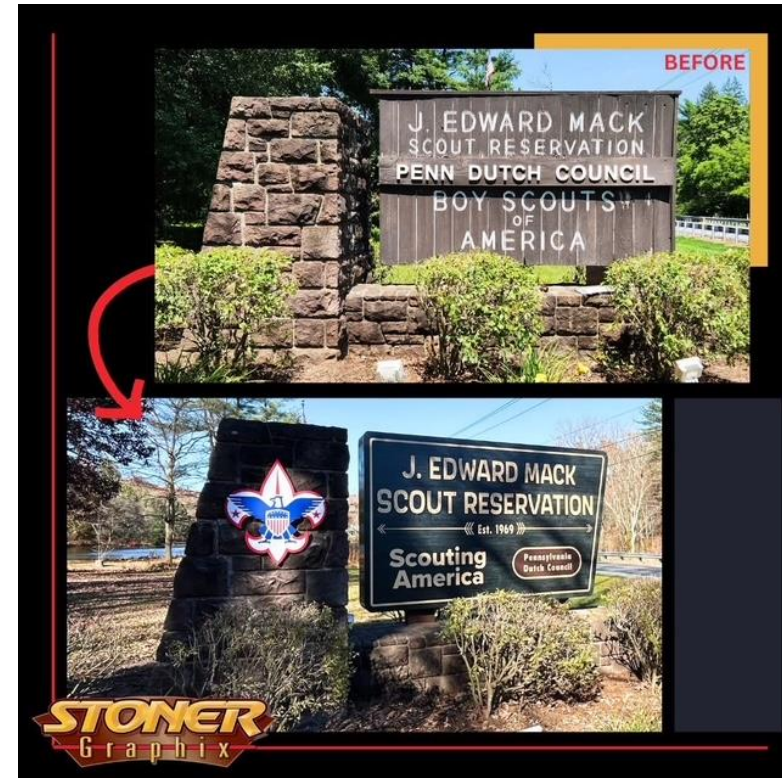
# Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops
