Potential for Mixed-Gender Camping

- Linked Troops
- Combined Troop Pilot
- District / Council Events
- Summer Camp
- High Adventure Activities







Guiding Principles

- Guide to Safe Scouting
- <u>Scouting's Barriers to Abuse</u>
- SAFE Checklist







Multiple Unit Events

- Combined pilot troops may always camp mixed
- Linked Troops (from same charter org) may always camp together with charter org approval
- Units from different charter orgs must have charter org AND council permission to camp together
- Special permission not needed for district/council events
- Each unit must provide adequate adult leadership

Tenting Considerations

- Mixed gender may share same campsite, but only with appropriate gender/age separation to ensure privacy
- Gender separation within tents or lodging
 - Same gender pairs in tents
 - Tenting alone is permitted
- Regular +/- 2-year age limit for tent buddy







Restroom Accommodations

- Regular separation by gender
- Regular separation of youth / adult
- If separate facilities not available, defined times must be posted for separate gender use







Buddy System

• 2-Buddy group must be same gender

 3-Buddy group may be mixed gender (except for tenting)

Other considerations

• Participants ages 18-21 must adhere to all adult rules

• Spouses may tent together







Consideration for Special Needs Scouts

 Special needs youth that require their parent or guardian in their tent must develop a plan with the Scout Executive
