

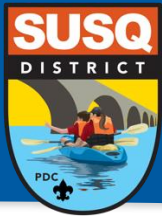

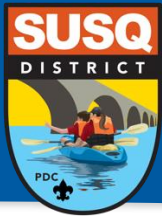

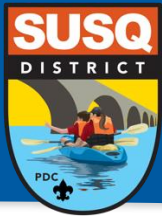

Award of the Month Interpreter Strip

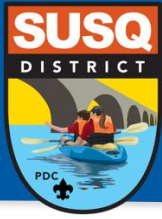

- Translating a two-minute speech or address
- Writing a letter in the language (does not apply for sign language)
- Translating 200 words from the written word

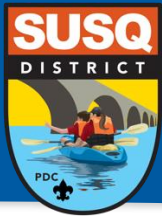

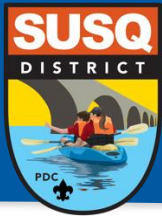
District Award of Merit
