## How to Participate:

Submissions are open to all registered Scouts in the Pennsylvania Dutch Council.

## Contest Guidelines:

Your design should capture the spirit, energy, and excitement of Scouting in our Council. Our current patch is a covered bridge with a horse-and-buggy on farmland. Think of other things that make our area special, such as nature, communities, food, or anything else you can think of!

## Patch designs must include:

1. The Scouting Fleur-de-lis
2. Must include the words "Pennsylvania Dutch Council"
3. Must fit the approved CSP shape template



Actual Size, including border, is 5" w x 2" h

## Patch design considerations:

- Submitted designs will be used as inspiration for the final patch; it is NOT guaranteed that a submitted design will be the final product.
- Designs do not need to be refined and finished; rough drawings are acceptable.
- Designs can be submitted in black and white or in color.
- Feel free to use the larger patch outline on the back to create your design.
